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Immediate Actions President Biden Must Take to Reduce Gun Violence

Homicides are surging across the country. The nation's gun homicide rate increased by 35% in 2020, and more than 90,000 Americans lost their lives to gun violence in the past two years. We are in the midst of a national public health crisis, but Congress is still refusing to pass gun safety legislation.

President Biden and Vice President Harris ran on the strongest gun safety ticket in presidential history. During the campaign, Joe Biden promised to take bold action to reduce gun violence and save lives — even if Congress stood in the way. **Now it's time for him to keep that promise.**

Issue regulations mandating near universal background checks.

An estimated 22% of US gun owners acquired their most recent firearm without a background check. Short of Congressional action, there are immediate steps President Biden must take to narrow these loopholes and save lives.

Nominate a new ATF director and issue an Executive Order to hold gun manufacturers and dealers accountable when they break the law.

An E.O. would send a strong signal that President Biden's ATF will stand up to decades of gun industry capture.
